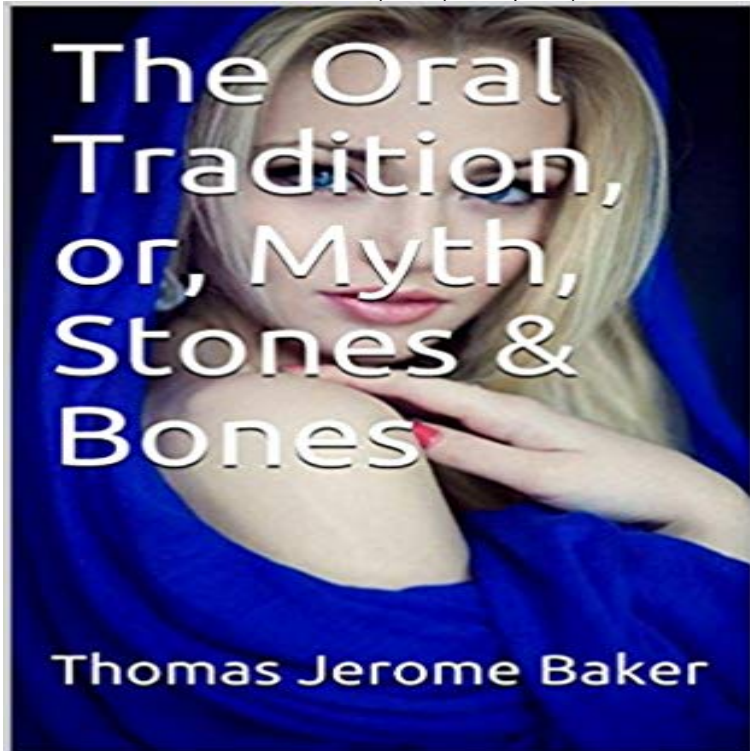


## The Oral Tradition, or, Myth, Stones & Bones
